Rules and Information

- 1. Derbyshire Junior Grand Prix series are held under Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules, and are licenced at Level 4.
- 2. All swimmers must be club train or club compete members of a Derbyshire club.
- 3. Swimmers who have previously entered any level 1 or level 2 swimming meet except the Derbyshire County Championships or Derbyshire Short Course Competition 2025 will not be eligible to enter. Swimmers will not be eligible to enter any events they have previously entered at the Derbyshire County Championships.
- 4. The Meet will be held at the venues and on the dates above.
- 5. Ages are as at midnight on Saturday 22nd November 2025.
- 6. The Events are:

9-12 years:

- 50m freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly
- 100m freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, Individual medley
- 200m freestyle
- 8 x 25m Cannon Relay

9-10 years:

- 4 x 25m Freestyle Relay
- 4 x 25m Medley Relay

11-12 years:

- 4 x 50m Freestyle Relay
- 4 x 50m Medley Relay
- 7. The female category is for birth sex female in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the female category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
- 8. Relay teams must consist of 4 open/males or 4 female of the correct age groups from a single club. For the cannon relay each team must consist of one open/male and one female of each age 9,10,11,12 from a single club.

- 9. The Arc pool, Matlock is 25m 8 lanes. The Pool will be equipped with anti-wave ropes, and automatic timing equipment will be used if available and operational. A secondary strobe will be provided where it is requested for an athlete at the time of entry.
- 10. Heats will be spearheaded according to submitted entry times (25m pool). Swimmers without entry times will swim in the first heats.
- 11. Only entries no faster than the Upper Cut Off times will be accepted.
- 12. Over the top starts may be used at the Promoter's discretion.
- 13. If the Meet is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted on a "first-come, first-served" basis. The Promoter reserves the right to limit entries to ensure we do not exceed the maximum time limit laid down by Swim England and the capacity of the venues. In the event that entries are rejected, the entry fee will be refunded, a single cheque will be made payable to the club in question.
- 14. Club entries must be made electronically. A SportSystems file set can be obtained by e-mail from juniorgrandprix@derbyshireswimming.org.uk or from the Derbyshire ASA website: https://swimderbyshire.uk/derbyshire-junior-grand-prix

Entries should be sent to <u>juniorgrandprix@derbyshireswimming.org.uk</u> and must include an entry report. These should be backed up with full payment and a completed cash summary sheet. **Please** ask for confirmation of receipt of electronic entries.

Paper entries are permitted for individual swimmers if they are not able to enter through their club.

15. The closing dates for entries are:

Round 1 – Saturday 30th August 2025

Round 2 – Saturday 20th September 2025

Round 3 - Saturday 8th November 2025

Late entries will not be accepted unless due to Promoter's error.

16. Each Round will consist of a single session.

Warm up 1.15pm, start 1.45pm. Estimated finish 4:45pm latest

Timings are subject to change and final timings will be published on the DASA website after the closing date for entries.

- 17. Awards will be presented to the top 3 scoring female and open/males in each age group after completion of the series of galas, calculated on a points basis as follows: Swimmers will be awarded 6 points for a win, 5 points for 2nd place and so on, with 1 point for 6th place.
- 18. An award will also be presented to the top scoring club. Clubs will also be awarded similar points for the relay events and double points for the cannon relay.
- 19. The entry fee per individual event is £7.00. There is no charge for relay entries
- 20. Coaches and team managers will need to obtain free Swim England accreditation that is available from https://www.swimmingresults.org/member options/. Accreditation will be required to access poolside and must be displayed at at all times. Ratios of coaches and team managers should be in accordance with Wavepower.



- 21. Adults will not be allowed poolside or in the sports hall at Matlock without accreditation. It is required that swimmers are supervised at all times both poolside and in the sports hall at Matlock.
- 22. Spectator admission prices, per gala:

• Adult: £5.00

Under 14s & over 65s: £3.00

- 23. A draft programme with details of all accepted swimmers will be available on the DASA website approximately five days prior to each round, to enable swimmers to check their entries and advise of any problems.
- 24. Swimmers must report to the Competitor Stewards immediately when their event is called. Any competitor not reporting on time for their event may be excluded from that event. Swimmers will be sent to the starting area by the Competitor Stewards.
- 25. Please help the running of the meet by advising of withdrawals where known. Withdrawals should be made by 6pm the day before the round. Please notify withdrawals to juniorgrandprix@derbyshireswimming.org.uk or use such other online method as may be advised to clubs. No refunds can be made after the closing date for each round unless with medical confirmation.
- 26. Results will be published on the DASA website after the event.
- 27. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at each of the leisure centres and must wear suitable footwear when leaving the Poolside.
- 28. The interpretation of these conditions and any conditions not covered by this information will be at the discretion of the Promoter, Lance Davis.
